




Fourth Graders Field Trip

This October, the grade 4 students had the opportunity to visit the Winooski One Hydro Plant and the McNeil Generating Station. These field trips supported our research around renewable and nonrenewable energy and helped students begin to answer our guiding question of "how do we affect the planet by the energy we use?".

At the Winooski One Hydro Plant, students took a tour of the facility and learned how the energy from water is used to make electricity and they were also able to recognize the similarities between hydropower and windmills.

At the McNeil Generating Station students wore hardhats and safety goggles as they toured the facility and learned how biomass is used to make electricity all the way from its initial transport on trains to the various buildings across the city.




